



### **Transportation**

### Location/Highways

Deshler, NE is located in western Thayer County, 9 miles west of the county seat Hebron. Highway 136 runs north of town. Deshler is 90 miles southeast of Grand Island, 103 miles southwest of Lincoln, and 158 miles southwest of Omaha.

#### Air

The Hebron Airport is located one mile south of Hebron on Highway 136. The airport has a 3,660 foot concrete runway that has pilot control lighting and a 2,513 foot by 150 foot grass runway.


The nearest rail service, BNSF Railway Company, is located in Belvidere, Nebraska, 17 miles northeast of Deshler.


#### Workforce



The Deshler Volunteer Fire Department provides fire protection to the village with a 32 member volunteer fire department. Deshler has one fire station.


#### Law Enforcement

### **Utilities**

### Nebraska Highlights

Energy costs are often a considerable part of any business' operational budget. These costs can vary greatly between states, but in Nebraska (the only state in the nation where all electric utilities are publicly owned) electric costs are passed to consumers at low, cost-ofservice rates. As a result, the state offers industrial rates well below the national average. Nebraska electric utilities achieve low rates, in part, because they draw from a balanced and efficient "mix" of generation resources.

### **Electricity**

Electric service is provided by Norris Public Power District (NPPD), a wholesale customer of Nebraska Public Power Distict (NPPD), and the City of Deshler provides retail electric service to Deshler.


#### **Natural Gas**

### Water & Sewerage

The municipal water system in Deshler is supplied by two wells. The system, serving the entire village, has a combined pumping capacity of 700 gallons per minute and an overhead storage capacity of 200,000 gallons. Deshler has a lagoon sewerage system. The aeration treatment plant has a daily capacity of 100,000 gallons.





### **Deshler School District**

Deshler Public Schools is located in Deshler and serves families in Thayer and Nuckolls Counties. It covers approximately 160 square miles. In 2023/2024 actual valuation of \$562,092,478 with an actual valuation per student of \$2,361,733. The school operating expenses for 2022-23 were \$4,990,000, with an average cost per pupil of \$22,871.

Bus services are provided between the communities. This Class C school is accredited by the Nebraska Department of Education. For more information, visit deshlerpublicschools.org.

Deshler Lutheran School is located in Deshler. It is offered to K-8th grade, and serves 48 students.

### **Educational Service Unit**

### **Higher Education**

Southeast Community College-Beatrice is 54 miles east of Deshler, Southeast Community College-Milford is 80 miles northeast of Deshler, York College is 60 mile north of Deshler, Hastings College is 66 miles northwest of Deshler, and Central Community College-Hastings is 63 miles northwest of Deshler.

An abundance of public colleges and universities are available in Nebraska. There are also a number of community colleges as well as private colleges and trade schools. A large number of degree programs are available and some institutions offer courses and workshops specially tailored to meet specific training needs of industry, education, and business.

### **Agriculture**

In 2021, Nebraska ranked first among all states in commercial cattle slaughter, Great Northern bean production, and popcorn production. The **Ogallala Aquifer** underlies 174,000 square miles in parts of eight states. The Ogallala Aquifer within Nebraska contains approximately 65 percent of the water storage in the entire aquifer. With the implementation of more efficient irrigation systems and other water management measures the Ogallala Aquifer will remain a valuable resource in Nebraska.

Nebraska's Natural Resource
Districts (NRDs) have responsibility
for managing groundwater
resources. The Nebraska
Department of Natural Resources
maintains responsibility for
administration of surface
water rights. In locations where
groundwater and surface water



are connected, the responsibility is shared among the NRDs and the state for achieving a sustainable balance between water supplies and water use.

#### Groundwater

One of Nebraska's most vital natural resources is its massive supply of groundwater. The High Plains Aquifer, also commonly referred to as the Ogallala Aquifer, stretches through parts of eight states, but its most abundant groundwater availability has been essential to the success of agriculture in the state.

Center pivot irrigation is the most common method of providing water to row crops in the state, and as a result, four of the largest manufacturers of center pivot systems in the world are located in Nebraska. Nebraska has more than 100,000 registered irrigation wells.

With the implementation of more efficient irrigation systems and other water management measures, the Ogallala Aquifer will remain a valuable resource in Nebraska.

An accessible water supply also is vital to Nebraska's livestock and dairy production.


### **Climate**

Nebraska has a continental climate, with hot summers and cold winters. Temperatures are highly variable from season to season and year to year.

Precipitation is also variable and ranges from an annual average of 15-20 inches in the west to 30-35 inches in southeast Nebraska.

The growing season in Nebraska fluctuates in length, but on average it ranges from 120 days in the extreme northwest to 170 days in the southeast.
