

Who is eligible for this program?

All employers/ businesses, any size, within Hebron's one-mile city limit jurisdiction.

What types of programs can be reimbursed?

Nontraditional students and those seeking advanced/up-skill degrees, including new high school graduates, qualify for this grant. The employee must be up to two years out of school to qualify for this program.

How much can be reimbursed?

Grant is matching up to \$3,000 max per employee. The grant must also be matched dollar-for-dollar and can exceed this grant's max amount.

What are the requirements to be reimbursed?

- Employer to complete application on behalf of employee—application will have a signature line for both the employee and the employer verifying they both agree to the terms.
- Employer/business location must be within Hebron's one-mile city limits jurisdiction and any size business can utilize this program.
- Employee must live in Thayer County during their employment while receiving the tuition reimbursement grant.
- Employee must be up to two years out of school to qualify for this program.
- Grant only goes towards college-related expenses (books, tuition, tools, computer software, etc.) that employee acquired during schooling. Room and Board are excluded.
